Dense rainforest, the desert cactus, and velvety moss create the perfect backdrop for any special event.

Experience the sights and fragrances of a wide variety of flowers and plants, all in their natural settings.

Spacious rooms feature stone paths that wind through the breathtaking gardens.

With separate space dedicated to special events, seasonal décor, and a children's garden, this destination is perfect for large sit down dinner functions or smaller, less formal occasions.

*The Community Room is available to not-for-profit, community groups and educational groups Monday-Wednesday at no charge.

*Reservations are accepted on a first come first served basis.

*Users may reserve the room no more than once per month and may be moved should the room be needed for a Conservatory function.

*Since the Conservatory is open to the public everyday from 9am-5pm, public spaces are not available until after 5pm daily.

*Evening rental fee includes 7-hour (4pm-6pm set-up, 6pm-10pm event, 10pm-11pm clean-up). Any event surpassing the 7 hours will be charged accordingly.

*Additional hours are \$500/hour.

*The Conservatory does not rent equipment.

*The client is responsible for un-stacking and restacking the tables and chairs if they choose to use the current inventory.

*Above fees do not include catering charges, refundable security deposit, or security officer fee.

*The Conservatory does not set-up or clean-up—this is the responsibility of the client

To Book

We do not issue any temporary holds on any dates. To officially reserve the Conservatory we require:

- 1) Special Event Venue Application
- 2) Non-Refundable Reservation Fee
- 3) \$35 Non-Refundable Application Fee.

The Reservation Fee is 50% of the Rental Fee or \$250 whichever is greater. For events with Rental Fees under \$250, the total non-refundable Rental Fee is due in order to secure your date.

The Reservation Fee will be applied towards your Balance Due, but it is non-refundable if you cancel (no exceptions).



Birthday/Shower Package

*Includes the use of the Jensen Room for a two (2) hour period between 9:00am-2:00pm daily.

*Includes the use of chairs and tables from existing inventory.

*Total cost: \$200

Parking/Transportation

There is a parking lot just south of the Conservatory, which can accommodate up to 150 vehicles. There is also ample street parking.

Also nearby is the Garfield stop on the CTA Green El Line. Please contact the Chicago Transit Authority for more information.



Inventory

The Conservatory currently has approximately:

- *22- Sixty inch (60") round tables
- *22- Six foot (6') rectangular tables
- *180- chairs (green iron with black iron trim)
- *6- Bistro Sets (24 chairs and 6 tables)

You may use the inventory free of charge. All other equipment must be rented from our Preferred Professionals.

Additional Information

CATERING

- All permittees are required to use a caterer from [Preferred Professional List](#) for ALL FOOD & BEVERAGE (including alcohol). Other than a wedding cake, the client is not allowed to supply any food or beverage.
- Cost to be determined by caterer.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL

- All permittees are required to use rental suppliers from [Preferred Professional List](#).
- Cost to be determined by rental supplier.

Additional Information Continued

SECURITY DEPOSIT

- All permittees are required to pay a refundable security deposit, up to a maximum of \$500. The amount will be refunded 30 business days after the event as long as there is no damage to the property and all rules and regulations are followed.
- Violations in which part or the entire security deposit will be withheld include: entering/exiting outside of reservation time, deliveries/pick-ups outside of reservation time, unauthorized vehicles on-site and/or on the grass.

SECURITY OFFICER

- All permittees are required to have at least three (3) Chicago Park District Security Officers on-site for all evening rental
- Security fee is \$30/hour, per Security Officer

INSURANCE

- The Chicago Park District requires any individual or group hosting an event on Chicago Park District property to obtain General Liability Insurance in the amount of \$1M naming the Chicago Park District as Additional Insured. The Park District also requires the Endorsement issued by the insurance carrier. You may obtain this insurance from any insurance company of your choosing. Serving alcohol will require additional insurance coverage of \$2M.
